The Peer Model Preschool Program is part of the Johnston Public Schools Special Education Early Childhood program which serves preschool children with developmental delays. We are excited to offer openings for typically developing children, 3 1/2 to 5 years old, to participate in an enriched learning environment focused on developing communication and language, social, self-help, motor and cognitive skills. Early literacy and math skills are emphasized and align with RI Early Learning & Development Standards. Peer models also learn leadership and helping skills by modeling appropriate play and communication for their classmates with developmental delays.

(proof of residency required)
- ◆ **Toilet trained**
- ◆ **Transportation provided by parent/guardian**
- ◆ **Updated Immunization Records**
- ◆ **Birth Certificate**
- ◆ **Child must be at least 3 1/2 years of age**
- ◆ **All eligibility requirements must be completed and submitted to the Principal for admission into the program.**
